High School - Black Forest League:

On February 12, the *Varsity* teams and *Girls-JV* played Vanguard. **Boys-Varsity** won 72-17, led by **Trevor McFarland** 13 points/1-2 FT's, **Nick Bennett** 12, **Andrew Edwards** 10, **Micah Collett** 8 (2 3's), **Logan Neff** 8/2-4 FT's; **Robbie Hart, Zach Plating, Andrew Perckett, Caleb Dillavou, and Joel Wetlesen** 4 each, **Cameron Dillavou** 1. **Girls-Varsity** cruised to a big 62-12 win vs. their League foe, led by **Elise Mann** 16 points/8 steals, **Ellen Brandenstein** 9 points, **Carolyn Schipper** 8 points/6 rebounds, **Ashley Branch** 8 points/3 blocks, **Heidi Mann** 8 points/9 assists/8 steals, and **Nikki Sotelo** 6 points. **Girls-JV** ran past Vanguard for a solid victory; **Lindsay Geving** led all scorers with 9, and her Freshman teammates **Miji Lee, Logan Davis, and Chelsea Kohl** each added 4. That evening, **Boys-C** hosted James Irwin and lost another close one, 27-31. The Eagles were led by **Jon Shaw** with 14 points and **Tony Baughman** with 6.

On February 14, the Eagles hosted the Hanover Hornets. **Girls-Varsity** beat the Hornets 69-17 for another League win with balanced scoring from **Ellen Brandenstein, Merrily Brast, and Elise Mann** with 12 points each.
