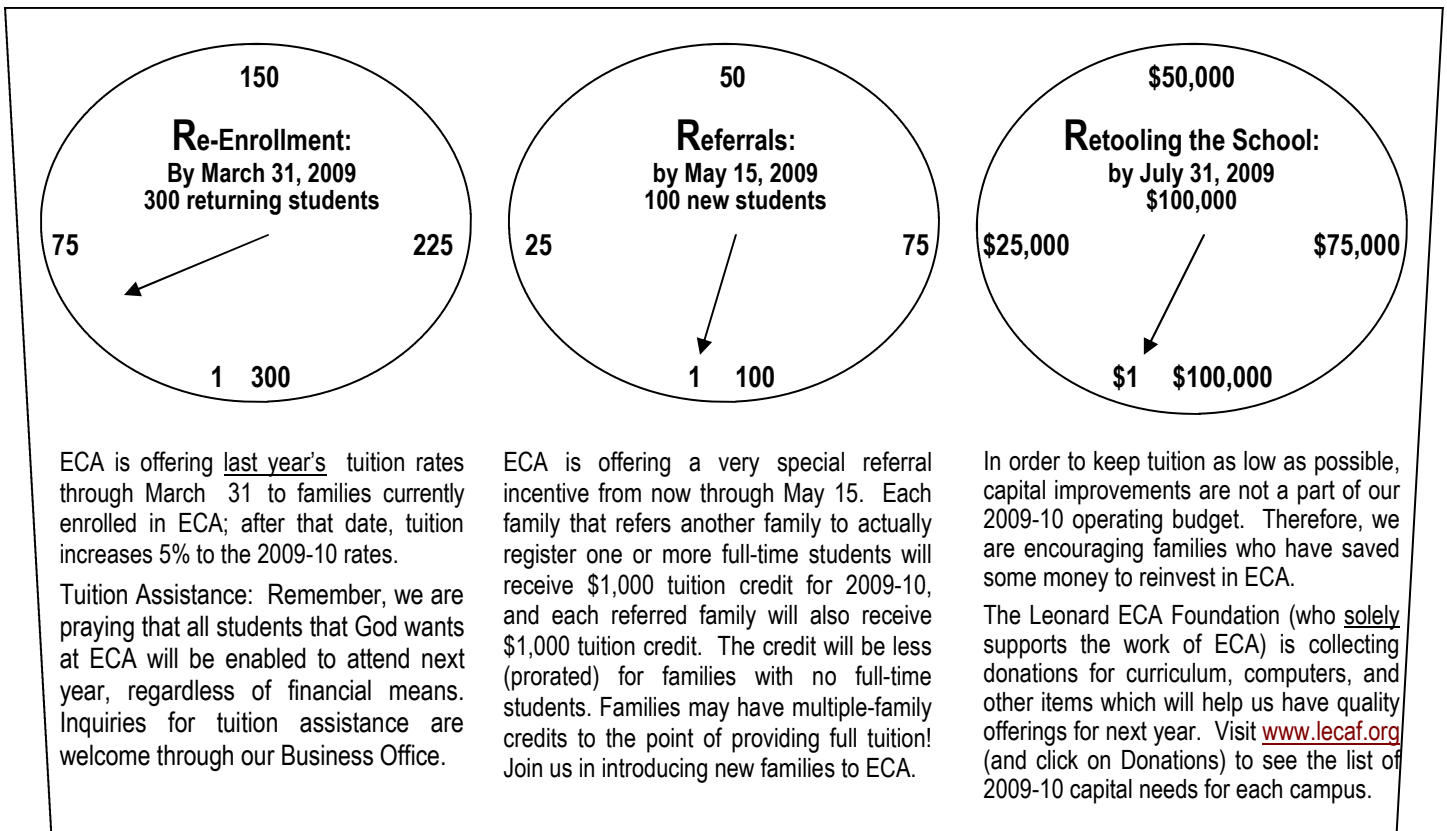

## **Black Forest League Basketball:**

On February 23, **Boys-Varsity** hosted the Simla Cubs in the Pigtail Game of the District VIII 2A Boys' Basketball Tournament and registered a strong 72-47 victory. **Zach Plating** led with 22 points (5 3's)/1-2 FT's, **Trevor McFarland** racked up 17 points (1 3-pointer)/2-2 FT's, followed by **Cameron Dillavou** 11 points (3 3's), **Logan Neff** 9 points/3-6 FT's, **Andrew Edwards** 7 points/1-2 FT's, **Andrew Perrett** 3 points/1-2 FT's, and **Caleb Dillavou** 3 points (1 3-pointer), advancing the Eagles to the first-round game the next evening vs. the Limon Badgers at Limon HS, the site for the Tournament. The Eagles played hard, led by **Trevor** with 19 points (2 3's)/5-7 FT's, **Zach** 12 points (3 3's)/1-2 FT's, **Andrew Edwards** 10 points/2-4 FT's, **Cameron** 5 points/1-2 FT's, and **Logan** 4 points/2-4 FT's for the 50-60 final score. In the Consolation Semi-final Game on February 26, the Eagles took on the Byers Bulldogs in an edge-of-your-seat thriller with an 18-19 score after the 1st period, then surged for a 40-32 half-time lead, hung in at 51-46 after the 3rd, and ended 67-68 at the final buzzer. **Zach** led with 18 points (3 3's)/3-3 FT's, **Trevor** 16 points (1 3-pointer)/3-4 FT's, **Cameron** 11 points (1 3-pointer), **Andrew** 8 points (1 3-pointer)/1-3 FT's, **Robbie Hart** 7 points (1 3-pointer), and **Logan** 6 points. Great job, Eagles - we are proud of you!

On February 25, the BFL League Champions and #1-seeded Lady Eagles hosted the Miami-Yoder Lady Buffaloes for the opening round of the District VIII 2A Girls' Basketball Tournament. The faithful Eagle fans cheered on their Lady Eagles to a 41-19 victory to advance to the Semi-final Game on February 27 vs. the Limon Lady Badgers. With their trademark coolheaded teamwork, the Lady Eagles beat the Lady Badgers 41-33 to advance to the District Championship Game the following day. Facing the Kiowa Lady Indians, the Lady Eagles came back to 57-65 for the 2nd Place trophy and advanced to the **Regional Tournament tomorrow and Saturday, March 6 and 7, at Florence High School.**

The District VIII-#2-seeded Lady Eagles take on the District II-#3-seeded Akron Lady Rams at **6:00pm tomorrow, Friday, at Florence HS.** (The District VI-#1-seeded Hoehne Lady Farmers play the District VIII-#6-seeded Pikes Peak Christian Lady Eagles at 3:00pm that same afternoon.) The two winning teams play at **1:00pm on Saturday** for an opportunity to advance to the **State 2A Tournament next Thursday - Saturday, March 12 - 14, at UCS-Pueblo.** Go Lady Eagles!!

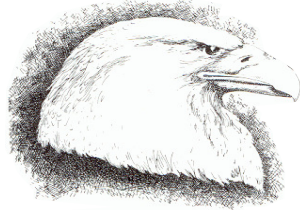
