Please do not schedule doctor or other appointments during testing days since make-up testing is not available.



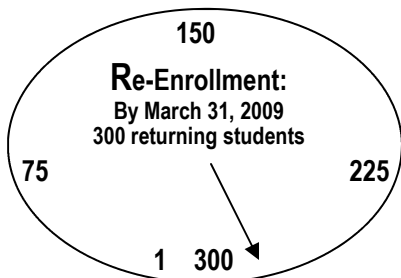
5th Grade Garage Sale & Pancake Breakfast - this Saturday, April 4!

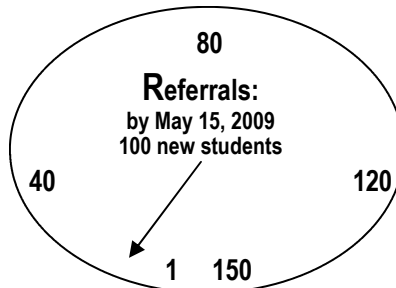

ECA: 425 Dashboard



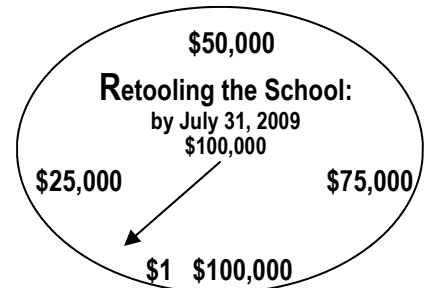

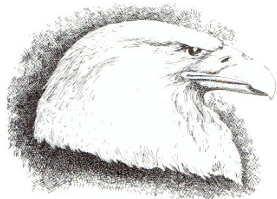
