The ECA Golf/Walk Classic will be held **Monday, September 29, at the Colorado Springs Country Club**. This is a regular-scheduled, **Delayed-Start** school day, and *all ECA students* and staff will attend as a school family to celebrate God's provision through this major fundraising event!

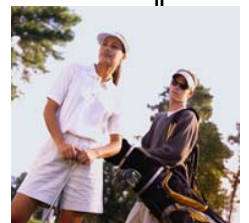
- * Regular shuttle riders will depart from the Secondary campus promptly at 9:30am (**Delayed-Start** shuttle schedule) and be driven to the Elementary campus.
- * All Seniors are to arrive at the Country Club at 9:40am and remain there.
- * High school driving students and passengers are to arrive at the Country Club at 9:40am and be shuttled to the Elementary campus: the High School students are to report to the Elementary Chapel, and Elementary siblings/passengers (in grades 1-6 only) are to report to the Elementary playground.
- * Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten students are to be dropped off at the Country Club at 10:15am.
- * All other Elementary students (grades 1-6) are to report to the Elementary playground between 9:30 and 9:55am.
- * High school non-driving students are to be dropped off at the Elementary campus by 10:00am and report to the Elementary Chapel.
- * Adult, fundraising walkers are to arrive at the Elementary campus at 10:30am.

After the arrival of all walkers at the Country Club, a lunch of hot dogs, chips, and sodas will be provided (water will be available); and after lunch, a variety of fun activities have been planned, including golf games, an inflatable bouncer, and the \$1,000,000 Hole-in-One Contest!

Adult fundraising walkers will depart at 2:30 - either by shuttle or walking back to the Elementary campus. Pick-up/departure for all non-shuttle students will be at 2:45pm from the Country Club; and shuttle riders will depart from the Country Club at 3:05 and arrive at the Secondary campus at 3:25.

Please take a moment to review the information; a copy has been included for Secondary parents to keep for convenience.
