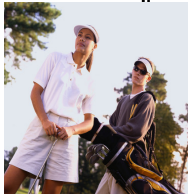

**College PSAT Testing**



PSAT testing is an excellent opportunity to practice for the College SAT and a measure of progress toward college admission. Also, students in the top 5% nationally may qualify to compete for the National Merit Scholarship. The PSAT is mandatory for all ECA Juniors and Sophomores and will be administered at ECA on **Wednesday, October 15**. The College Board's fee for the testing is \$13 (payable to ECA) which includes the test, an informational publication, and a practice test.

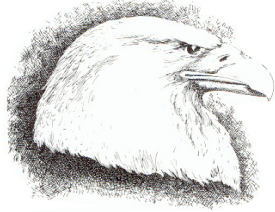
