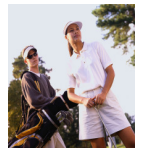


ECA Golf/Walk Classic 2008!

Eagle Soccer! On October 9, the Eagles played TCA "under the lights." The Eagles' practice shooting outside the 18 and "bending" the ball toward the net paid off when **Braxton Finch** scored first with a long shot that bent right-left into the goal. The half ended 1-0 ECA but TCA scored on a direct kick in the 2nd. The Eagles went into attack mode and, with 10 minutes to play, **Braxton** received a through-ball down the left for a 1-on-1 with the TCA keeper. Hearts stopped as he sped toward the goal, ready to shoot. With 2 Titan defenders quickly closing in, **Braxton** passed in front of the keeper to **Chris Kennedy** who was in full stride toward the net - SCORE! The Eagles kept pressure on the Titans for the 2-1 win! On October 11, the Eagles played CSCS, ranked #1 in the State. Knowing it would be a tough game, the Eagles played well and held it to 0-3 at the half. 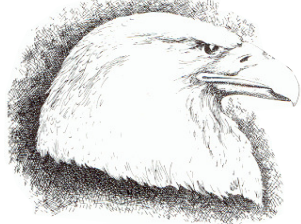
