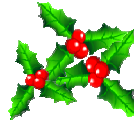

Alissa and **Alyssa's** team headed to Zambia to minister to AIDS orphans - nurturing them, washing their feet, and giving them shoes they had brought along for them. After their time in Zambia, their missionary group spent a week in Ethiopia reflecting on their life-changing experiences before heading home.

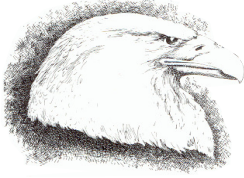

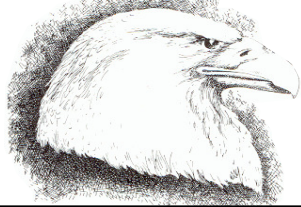
