Classical Elements of ECA

As the only PreK-12 Christian and Classical school in Colorado Springs, ECA offers its students a unique educational experience. Instruction is tailored to complement a child's natural development from a learner of facts to a critical and abstract thinker and finally to a confident, persuasive communicator.

- **Latin** – The study of Latin leads to better performance in English vocabulary, grammar, spelling, and writing.
- **Logic** – Students learn critical thinking skills and develop the ability to discern truth.
- **Classical Literature** – The great works of literature and philosophy that shaped Western culture and history are read and analyzed.
- **Rhetoric** – Students focus on persuasive communication through composition, speech, and debate.



Electives and Activities



ECA's elective courses include:

- Advanced Placement Courses

- Computer Applications
- Multiple Instrumental and Vocal Ensembles
- Formal Art Instruction
