## **BFL High School Basketball**

**Boys' Varsity** is currently 7-2 with victories over Kiowa and Alexander Dawson. Leading in stats are **Zach Plating** with 172 points/19.1 ppg/66% shot percentage/26 3's; **Andrew Edwards** 115 points/12.8 ppg/33 rebounds/15 steals/16 blocks, **Trevor McFarland** 98 points/10.9 shot percentage/5 3's/11-15, 73% free throws/29 rebounds/21 steals; **Cameron Dillavou** 49 points/87% shot percentage/6 3's/63 assists/39 steals; **Titus Rice** 31 points/6 steals/5 blocks; **Seth Fuller** 26 points/6 steals/3 blocks; **Robbie Hart** 26 points/15 assists/15 steals; **Caleb Dillavou** 26 points/86% free throws/7 assists/7 steals; **Andrew Perrett** 24 points/75% shot percentage/4 3's/13 assists/4 steals; and **Charles Rice** 20 points/4 3's/4 assists/4 steals.

**Girls' Varsity** have had a great start, winning their first 7 games before losing to Kiowa on January 15 for an 8-1 record to-date. The Lady Eagles have balanced scoring with **Merrily Brast** and **Ellen Brandenstein** as the leaders. The team plays pressure defense and is led in steals and assists by **Heidi Mann** and a strong effort from **Julia Morin**. **Ashley Branch, Abby Chu, and Ellen Brandenstein** lead the way in rebounds; the Lady Eagles also have a strong bench with **Carolyn Schipper, Sydney Bost, Lorraine Lefever, Bekah von Haasl, Kim Schipper, and Ashley Bates**. The Lady Eagles are holding their opponents to 32 points/game while averaging 50 points/game for 2nd place in District VIII.

**Boys' JV** are hot on the trail with 4 recent victories: January 9 vs. Cripple Creek-Victor (38-30), the Pioneers went 12-4 in the 4th period, but the Eagles held on for the win. **Andrew Crews** scored 9 points; **Stephen Spees** 7; **Austin Becker** and **Baylor Finch** 6 each; **Vince Brackett** 4; **Brett McFarland, Erik Brouwer, and Nick Branch** 2 each. The Eagles hosted the Florence Huskies on January 12 (42-31): **Stephen** was 3-6 for free throws, scored 9 points, and dished out 4 assists. **Simeon Kaan** played well with a 3-pointer in the 2nd period and 6 points in the 3rd. **Brett** hit 2 3's and added another bucket for 8 points; **Austin** scored 6; **Tony Baughman** 4; **Baylor** and **Andrew** 3 each. January 15 vs. the Kiowa Indians (35-22): **Bradley Allen** had his best game with 8 points, including a 3-pointer, and 4 steals, and even took a charge which is what "Floor Burn U" is all about! **Simeon** led with 9 points and added 5 rebounds; **Baylor** scored 6 with 9 steals and 2 blocked shots; **Brett** added 5 points/6 rebounds; **Andrew Bostrom** scored a big 3-pointer in the 4th to help push the lead; **Caleb Dillavou** and **Andrew Crews** each scored 2. January 16 vs. Alexander Dawson (49-34): **Simeon** scored 9 points on 3 3-pointers; **Caleb** scored 8 including 2 3's. **Andrew Crews** added 8 steals to his 8 points; **Austin** and **Nick** scored 5 each. **Baylor** scored 4 and added 10 rebounds. **Tony** scored 3; **Stephen, Eric LeFever, and Brett** 2 each; **Bradley** 1.

**Girls-JV and Girls-C.** No results have been posted.

**Boys-C** played tough against Calhan on January 6 despite not having 3 key players. **Nick Branch** scored a season-high 13 points and grabbed 5 rebounds; **Hee Do Yu** had his best game of the season with 9 points, 5-7 free throws; and **Vince Brackett** added 6 points/5 rebounds. The Eagles hit a cold spell in the 3rd period and ended the game in a close 35-38 loss. On January 9, the Eagles crushed RMCA 49-11. **Nick** led with 14 points/9 rebounds; **Eric Lefever** added 13 points; **Hee Do** scored 6; **Andrew Bostrom** 5; **Tyler Gendron** and **Ben Kirkpatrick** 3 each, and **Vince** 2. On January 12 vs. the Florence Huskies, the Eagles committed 26 fouls and had to sit 2 starters and ended the game 39-45. **Hee Do** led with 10 points, **Nick** 9, **Andrew** and **Vince** 8 each, and **J.D. Kohl** and **Eric** 2 each.

## **BFL Junior High Basketball**

**Girls-A** closed out 2009 with a 20-18 upset win over Calhan; on January 11, the girls added a 18-8 win over Miami-Yoder. The Lady Eagles' defense pressured throughout the game, and **Stephanie Holt** had a strong game with 2 blocked shots/1 steal and numerous forced turnovers. **Leah Bost** led the offense with 9 points; **Shannon Brown** played a strong post game with 5 points/4 rebounds; **Kylie Hartnett** and **Karina Milvain** added 2 each. The team have faced the top 2 BFL teams: On January 14 vs. Vanguard (13-34): **Lauren Brandenstein** led with 4 points; **Jessica Childress** had 3; **Leah Bost, Rachel Ritchhart, and Karina Milvain** 2 each. **Lauren** had 3 rebounds/4 blocked shots/3 assists; **Rachel** had 7 steals. On January 18 vs. CSS (6-29): **Leah** had 4 points and **Karina** 2. **Lauren** had 3 rebounds/4 blocked shots/3 assists; **Rachel** forced 4 jump balls on defense.

**Boys-A** is currently 10-2 following wins over Calhan 38-23, Miami-Yoder 42-6, Vanguard 40-34, and CSS 32-26.

**Boys-B** has added 4 consecutive wins, over Calhan 27-15, Miami-Yoder 22-19, Vanguard 23-9, and CSS 34-13, for a 11-1 current record.
