ACSI Accreditation Update, Volunteer and Prayer Call

ECA is preparing to be accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) once again, but this time it's different. This time the Elementary campus is being examined for re-accreditation while the Secondary campus is being scrutinized for the first time. The process allows ECA to evaluate itself on ten key standards established by ACSI. Then, in April of 2010, an accreditation team of Christian school representatives from a multi-state region will validate this self-study.

The ECA board, administrators, faculty, and staff are currently focused on producing this self-study. The time, thought, and energy invested in this process has already enhanced the quality of Christian education at ECA.

- 3) Home and Community Relations and Student Services
- 4) Personnel
- 5) Instructional Program
- 6) Library, Media and Technology Services

- 8) Facilities, Environment, and Transportation
- 9) Character, Values, and Spiritual Development of Students
- 10) Continuous School Improvement Plan

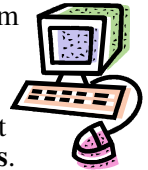
