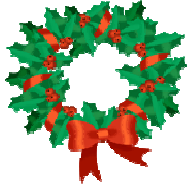
### ECA Matchwits!

## **BFL High School Basketball**

The **Varsity** teams kicked off their season with the Lutheran-Parker Invitational Tournament on December 4 and 5. **Boys' Varsity** beat Vail Christian 65-40. Leading the Eagles were **Andrew Edwards** with 17 points/5 rebounds/4 steals; **Charles Rice** 12 points (4/4 3 pointers)/4 rebounds/2 steals; **Trevor McFarland** 7 points/7 rebounds/2 steals/1 assist; **Robbie Hart** 5 points/7 rebounds/2 steals/5 assists; **Cameron Dillavou** 4 points/4 rebounds/3 steals/6 assists; and **Andrew Perkett** 4 points/1 rebound/1 steal/4 assists. The Eagles lost a close game to Lutheran-Parker 52-63 for the 2nd Place trophy.

**Girls' Varsity** opened the Tournament with a sound victory over Vail Christian, 59-26, with balance scoring led by **Ellen Brandenstein**, 13 points, and **Ashley Branch** 11. The Lady Eagles took on Lutheran-Parker and prevailed 46-44 to bring home the 1st Place trophy! Leading were **Merrily Brast** with 16 points (4 3-pointers) and **Heidi Mann** 10. On December 12 the team traveled to Custer County to take on the Bobcats. After a slow start, the Lady Eagles prevailed 49-36 with balanced scoring led by **Ellen**, **Merrily**, and **Carolyn Schipper** who contributed 8 points each.

The **JV** teams kicked off their season with the Edison Invitational Tournament on December 4 and 5. **Boys' JV** took 2nd Place, winning over Vanguard 38-26 with **Erik Brouwer** scoring 8 points, and losing the Championship Game vs. Edison's Varsity team 31-47. **Andrew Crews** led the Eagles with 10 points and **Stephen Spees** scored 8. At Custer County, the Eagles soundly beat the Bobcats for a 2-1 season to date.
