- **All Students:** Lunches, coats/jackets, and books must be stored in your lockers during the school day. Additional bags must be stored on top of your locker or on the ground under your locker. No bags may be left in the middle or opposite side of the hallway.
  - **Band Students:** Your instruments and music must be kept in the area built for them.
- ▶ **High School students:** Please join us **TOMORROW (Tuesday) from 7:00-7:45am in the Library** for prayer and devotions on "The Full Armor of God" (Ephesians 6).
- ▶ **BAND students - reminder:**
- 1) your instruments are to be kept in the storage area only - not in hallways or rooms.
  - 2) the storage area is for instruments and music only - you may not keep your clothes, books, lunches, etc. in that area. All personal items are to go in your lockers or bags.
- ▶ **Reminder:** When you put anything in the kitchen refrigerator, mark it with your name, or it's up for grabs! **Unmarked, expired, and opened items** will be discarded at the end of every week!!!
- ▶ **Reminder - cell phones and other electronic items are to be turned off and kept in your lockers.**
- ▶ **Reminder - the copy machine at the end of the upper hallway is NOT for student use at any time!**
- ▶ **Important reminders regarding posters, flyers, signs, etc.**

**These are extras that go in occasionally as needed or space allows:**

- ▶ **Please note the new changes to the Standardized Dress Code:**

**1) Friday-wear Dress Code Policy**

On Fridays, students may wear blue jeans with any of the following type of shirts:

- a. A collared shirt or dress crew neck shirt of any color (Standardized Dress Code wear)
- b. An ECA t-shirt of any color. The t-shirt must have the ECA logo or the ECA name. No other t-shirts are allowed. ECA t-shirts are available for purchase from the school.

**2) Uniform/Jersey Dress Code Policy**

Students who participate in ECA athletics, choir, drama or any other school-sponsored, extra-curricular activity are permitted to wear their jersey or uniform on the day of the event or performance. Students who participate in activities that are not affiliated or sponsored by ECA are required to gain the permission of an administrator before they may wear a non-ECA jersey or uniform.

- ▶ **Attention all Techno-Isolationists!** The use of electronic devices, including **cell phones, camera phones, iPods, and CD players** is not allowed on school property. Please keep these items stored in your locker during the school day. Instead, experience the freedom of speaking to one another face to face without your ears plugged by headphones or without your friend texting someone else as you try to share your deepest thoughts.
- ▶ **All students in the hallways during class time must have a pass.**
- ▶ **Students need a pass from the Study Hall teacher in order to work in the Library (available on Mondays-Wednesdays-Fridays only) during Study Hall. Students not working will be sent back to Study Hall and may have their computer rights revoked.**
- ▶ **BAND students:** 1) your instruments are to be kept in the storage area only - not in hallways or rooms.  
2) the storage area is for instruments and music only - you may not keep your clothes, books, lunches, etc. in that area. All personal items are to go in your lockers or bags.
- ▶ **By 3:15pm, all students not involved with practices or after-school activities must either leave campus or study in Room 115. No one should be roaming the halls or unattended in classrooms after 3:15pm.**

**Reminders!**

**1) Regarding lunch period - please be advised:**

- \* **Only Seniors are permitted to eat their lunch outside of the cafeteria. Student Council or Ensemble members may eat with the respective groups on those days designated to meet. All other students are to eat in the cafeteria.**
- \* **Students are not to use the microwaves in the kitchen for any reason.**
- \* **Eating utensils are free only for those who order Hot Lunch. Others may purchase a fork or spoon from a Hot Lunch mom for \$.25 each.**

- ▶ **1) When the tardy bell rings for each class, the door to each classroom will be shut. Students who walk through the door without a tardy slip will be sent to the office to obtain a tardy slip**

before they may enter the classroom.  
Unexcused tardies will be recorded in the student's record for that quarter of school and the appropriate discipline, as noted in the Student Handbook, will be applied, which is:

Tardies Per Quarter (9 weeks) -	1 <sup>st</sup> – 3 <sup>rd</sup> tardy:	Verbal Warning to Student

	5 <sup>th</sup> tardy:	One-day Suspension
