## **ECA Annual Report – As One Year Ends, Another Year Begins**

### **Highlights from the 2016-17 School Year:**

- ▶ ECA completed its 46<sup>th</sup> school year!
- ▶ With the Class of 2017, we surpassed the 700-graduate mark!
- ▶ \$27,000 of outside grants helped to make ECA affordable to families in need!
- ▶ ECA concluded its first-ever live remote course – through an instructor in Pittsburgh!
- ▶ We continued preparation to become accredited through the Association of Classical Christian Schools!
- ▶ ECA received cash gifts in excess of \$300,000 to support the ministry here!
- ▶ We completed the year within about 1% of our \$2,000,000 budget!

Thanks to the work of many, ECA continues to provide a quality Classical Christian educational experience for our students and their families, holding fast to the Christian faith through the biblical integration of every subject. This has been and will continue to be a strong point of emphasis for our school! While the world around us may be looking to fashion gods for itself, or attempt to live outside the dominion of God, we strive to remain steadfast in acknowledgment of the Creator God of the universe, who through His Son Jesus Christ has bought us back to Himself! Through the means of the Classical approach, our desire is for our students to understand the truth, reason in truth, and become persuasive for truth! In combining these aspects of faith and Classical education, we will continue to pursue accreditation through ACCS.

### **Looking ahead to the 2017-18 School Year:**

- ▶ Enrollment growth has been seen in our Elementary, Secondary, and Collegium!
- ▶ \$66,000 has been committed from outside grants to help ECA become a school of choice!
- ▶ ECA is now just one year away from having its first “second-generation” graduate!
- ▶ An accreditation visit from ACCS seems plausible for Spring, 2018!
- ▶ We continue to pray for a positive financial year where the school is both completely out of debt and with more assets than liabilities!
- ▶ ECA’s young men and women are growing and developing into the next generation of those who uphold the truth of Scripture and live according to a righteousness that is only available through the sacrifice of Christ!

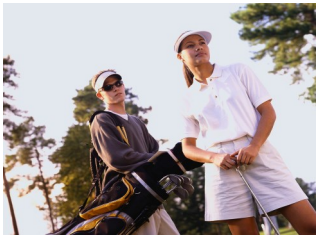
