## **Psalm 107 - A Psalm of Thanksgiving: A Guide for Parents of a Distressed Generation of Students**

Many children in this challenging era are without hope in a plethora of distressful situations. The natural response of parents is to shelter their children from these stressors or perhaps even attempt to solve their children's problems for them so that they never have to deal with them. However, I believe that these challenging situations can actually provide parents with an opportunity to allow their children to become familiar with several key elements of our faith practice. In working through suffering and reliance upon our Lord with an acquaintance, students can begin to see the provision of comfort in their lives. We should be thankful for these opportunities and seize them while our children are still at home and under our care!

Consider this lesson an opportunity for you to have a time of devotion with your family. Start by reading Psalm 107. This Psalm has a poetic structure that contains four stanzas incorporated into the narrative. Consider breaking up your reading into the following sections: verses 1-9, 10-16, 17-22, 23-31, and finally the concluding exhortation in verses 32-43. The poetry highlights four distressful situations. In each, a calamity comes upon a person or people; and it is apparent that these people are being redeemed to/by the Lord. Remember, redemption is key to understanding our relationship with Christ. Ultimately, the distressed people cry out to the Lord in their trouble and He delivers them from their distress. A solution to their problems is provided by the Lord. Finally the people are exhorted to thank the Lord for His steadfast love.

Walk through the objective of each stanza with your family – applying His truth to stressful situations!

- \* The steadfast love of the Lord endures forever - He loves us even when we have trials.
- \* Distress comes to most (if not all) people - don't think you are alone when you have challenges.
- \* There is a way to cry out during stressful situations - we are not without hope or action.
- \* Our cries should be directed to the Lord - He is always available to hear about our troubles.
- \* The Lord leads, delivers, sends His Word, and calms the storms - He provides peace.
- \* Take time to thank Him for His steadfast love and for His wondrous love for the children of man.

The next time you sense that your children are in a pickle, remember this passage and take time to work through this reminder of Christ's love and redemption! I trust it will give your family solid Christian counsel resulting in rest in Him.

As I close, let's all attempt to understand that the pressures of the world are tempting children to create their own path, indeed, to fashion for/of themselves their own "gods." The time we take now to familiarize our children with the Lord and His ways will not return void.
