

## **2020 BASKETBALL OPPORTUNITIES GRADES 5-6**

If your child is interested in playing basketball for ECA in the Christian Schools Athletic League, please return the attached form to the elementary office by Friday, December 6th. The teams are open to all students in grades 5-6 who are academically eligible.

### **WHEN IS THE SEASON?**

**A parent meeting will be held on Monday, December 9<sup>th</sup> at 2:30 in the Elementary gym.** Practices will begin the week of January 8, 2020 at NEBC. After the pre-season practices, there will be 2-3 practices or games per week **tentatively** scheduled for Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays (depending on coaches and gym availability). There will be a pre-season tournament on Saturday, January 11<sup>th</sup>, 6 regular season games, and a post-season tournament February 6-8.

### **WHAT IS OUR GENERAL PHILOSOPHY?**

The C.S.A.L. provides students with the opportunity to learn life lessons associated with competitive athletics in an environment that integrates Christian values within a developmental athletic program. Every player will play in every game unless they are ineligible. However, the amount of playing time is determined by the coach and should be based on “Standards for Participation” found in the parent-student handbook.

### **WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION?**

- 1. Return the “Permission for Participation” form to the elementary office by Friday, December 6th.**
- 2. Have a current (within one year) physical on file.**
- 3. The \$75 fee will be billed to your account after participation is confirmed.**
- 4. Returned a signed NEBC Waiver.**
- 5. Students must abide by the “Standards for Participation” and Eligibility Policies listed in the Co-Curricular Activities Section of the ECA Student-Parent handbook.**
- 6. Please DO NOT PUT ANY PART OF THE UNIFORM IN A DRYER. Please air dry them.**
